

The monthly meeting of the West Chillisquaque Township Supervisors was held on April 1, 2013 at the Municipal Building. Chairman Vaughn Murray, Vice Chairman Doug Everitt, and Supervisor Willard Miller were present. Chairman Murray called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Prior notice of the meeting was given via a Standard-Journal advertisement. The secretary's minutes of March 4, 2013 were approved. Upon motion by Miller, seconded by Everitt, and unanimously approved, the financial report including total disbursements was approved subject to audit.

Under the Solicitor's report, Benion the contempt petition had been filed against Bowes.

Under Zoning Officer Report, Murray reported the flood issues should soon be resolved..

Under the Roadmaster Report, Murray reported the permit had been received for the Mt. Zion pipe replacement project. The Solicitor and Light-Heigel will work on the easement issues. The Solicitor has completed the temporary and permanent easements for the sinkhole issue. The Roadmaster recommended planting grass where Miller's ditch was cleaned out.

Under the Planning Commission Report, Bob Pardoe, Jr. presented the amendment to the zoning ordinance. Upon motion by Miller, seconded by Everitt, and unanimously approved, the Solicitor was authorized to prepare and advertise the ordinance and public hearing for the June meeting. A letter was received officially withdrawing the land development application for the North Union Soccer Association. Bob Pardoe, Jr. thanked June Lewis for her efforts in getting the project moved to the Lewisburg Area School District sports complex.

Under the EMA Report, Murray reported the April 18<sup>th</sup> meeting would need to be rescheduled.

Under Unfinished Business, upon motion by Murray, seconded by Miller, and unanimously approved, Carl Pardoe was appointed to serve as our representative on the MACAC with Doug Everitt as the alternate representative. Dave Edinger and Carl Pardoe presented the paperwork for the Sodom School parking lot. It will be submitted to Light-Heigel for any stormwater issues. The secretary was asked to get an update from the County regarding the Rishel Bridge project. Everitt will have MRSA prepare ID badges for the Supervisors and Road Crew. Murray has submitted the traffic signal grant application to MAIDA for completion. The newsletter will probably be ready for May, 2013. Jeff Moser discussed issues with the temporary signage for the Rt. 405 road closure. Murray will contact Lynda Culver regarding the matter.

Under New Business, upon motion by Miller, seconded by Everitt and unanimously approved, the Road Crew was authorized to attend the West Branch Equipment Show on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Upon motion by Miller, seconded by Everitt, and unanimously approved, the final release on the Reiff project was authorized based on recommendation from Light-Heigel. Upon motion by Everitt, seconded by Miller, and unanimously approved, the stone bids were accepted with a third party delivery by Michael Culp. A MidLand representative gave a presentation on road work.

There being no Public Comments, Chairman Murray adjourned the meeting at 8:25 P.M.
