

The monthly meeting of the West Chillisquaque Township Supervisors was held on August 5, 2013 at the Municipal Building. Chairman Vaughn Murray and Supervisor Willard Miller were present. Chairman Murray called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Prior notice of the meeting was given via a Standard-Journal advertisement. The secretary's minutes of July 8, 2013 were approved. Upon motion by Miller, seconded by Murray, and unanimously approved, the financial report including total disbursements was approved subject to audit.

Under Public Comments, Kevin Shaffer stated that individuals were using the maintenance shed property for a shooting range. Upon motion by Miller, seconded by Murray, and unanimously approved, the Roadmaster will post no trespassing, no hunting, and no shooting signs on the property. Tilghman Shrawder requested 35 MPH speed limits sign be installed on Old Orchard.

Under the Solicitor's report, Attorney Benion reported that Judge Saylor gave Bowes 60 days to finish cleaning up their property. The preliminary drainage easements for Spotts, Caldwell/Loose were distributed to the Roadmaster and Supervisors for their review.

Under the Roadmaster Report, the sinkhole has been completed and work has begun on Mt. Zion Rd. pipe. Upon motion by Miller, seconded by Murray, and unanimously approved, the Roadmaster is to contact Midland Asphalt regarding the discrepancy between the proposal and the actual bills for the roadwork performed. Barry Garverick of PennDot inspected Industrial Park Road because of oil bleeding through. Since the work is still under warranty, the Roadmaster is to contact Midland Asphalt regarding that problem.

Under the Planning Commission Report, the issue of the Spotts subdivision was discussed. Attorney Benion agreed that it is a minor subdivision but that the land development plan calls for stormwater issues to be addressed either with a study or a request for a waiver. The matter was referred back to the Planning Commission for further consideration. Murray reported that Everitt had attended the County stormwater meeting. Future meetings will be attended by either Everitt or Pardoe.

Under the Zoning Hearing Board Report, Shane Murray reported the Freedom Church was approved to occupy the former Heartline building.

Under Unfinished Business, upon motion by Murray, seconded by Miller, and unanimously approved, Ordinance No. 122 was adopted. At this point, Miller left the meeting, thus adjourning the rest of the meeting due to a lack of a quorum. Murray continued with an informational session and reported that MRSA would provide the ID badges at no cost to us.

Under the EMA Report, Murray stated that a new coordinator would be appointed next month.

There being no Public Comments, Chairman Murray adjourned the meeting at 8:00 P.M.
